

Instructions for spectators for the raceday in Prague-Velká Chuchle (27 June):

- ▶ Gates open: from 10:30.

- ▶ Every person, with the exception of children under the age of 6, must prove one of the following documents:
 - confirmation of the POC test for the presence of SARS CoV-2 virus antigen with a negative result, not older than 72 hours (can also be used in testing at work /school/: confirmation by the employer /school/)
 - valid proof of vaccination against Covid-19 - for a two-phase vaccine for at least 21 days from the first vaccination, for a single vaccine for at least 14 days
 - a valid document of Covid-19 disease, not older than 180 days

A PERSON WHO DOES NOT COMPLY WITH THE CONDITIONS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED INTO THE AREA!

For people who have not taken the test in the last seven days, there will be a free antigen testing tent in front of the main entrance from 11:00 to 15:00 (other people: test for pay 350 CZK). The capacity is set to the expected number of people, however, in the case of the planned use of this testing, we recommend counting on time with arrival to take the test and evaluate the test in the order of minutes to low tens of minutes.

- ▶ All persons in the race area, with the exception of horse riders, are obliged to use respiratory protection – a respirator or similar device.

- ▶ Persons in the auditorium of the grandstand are obliged to take their seats so that they have at least one free seat between them (does not apply to members of the common household).

- ▶ It will be possible to buy refreshments at the racecourse, but there is a ban on the consumption of food and beverages in the auditorium of the grandstand.

- ▶ There will be places for betting (paddocks, small and large betting halls) in operation at the racecourse.

- ▶ Prize-giving ceremonies will take place.
